

Fall Semester 2017 Internship Opportunity with the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC)



The FWC's Wildlife Impact Management Section is looking for up to two interns for the 2018 spring semester (January – May 2017) to assist in the section's goals of managing human-wildlife conflict. Interns will have the opportunity to work on a variety of challenging projects involving human-wildlife conflict with native species and invasive fish and wildlife management. Interns will be working at the FWC Headquarters in Tallahassee for 10–20 hours per week during the course of the semester.

This is an unpaid internship opportunity with the possibility of earning academic credit (3 to 6 credit hours) for eligible students.

Applicants should be highly motivated individuals with excellent verbal and written communication skills and an interest in gaining professional experience in a team setting. Juniors and seniors of all majors are encouraged to apply. A minimum 3.0 GPA is required.

Examples of potential projects include:

- Data entry and quality assessment
- Newsletter development
- Program branding
- External contact list compilation
- Writing nonnative species profiles
- Community outreach

The FWC takes pride in achieving its mission of “Managing fish and wildlife resources for their long-term well-being and the benefit of people.” Interns will have the opportunity to work on challenging nonnative species management and human-wildlife conflict issues and gain a better understanding of how the FWC manages wildlife resources on a day to day basis and for the long term.

This semester's internships will begin on January 8, 2018 and end on April 27, 2018. Interested applicants must submit the following items to be considered:

- Current résumé
- Cover letter explaining the applicant's qualifications and interest in this internship
